The project consists of the following, including, but not limited to:

Removing and replacing existing damaged concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk; removing and replacing existing valley gutters; removing and replacing existing concrete driveways; removing and replacing existing median island curb and/or curb and gutter; removing existing sidewalk and installing ADA curb ramps; removing and replacing asphalt pavement in conjunction with the concrete work; miscellaneous concrete work as directed; and all other work necessary for a complete project in accordance with City of San Ramon Standard Details and Specifications and Caltrans 2010 Standard Plans and Specifications. Bids are required for the entire work described herein.

The project contract amount will be **three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)**. The contract duration will be until the contract amount has been exhausted or December 31, 2018, whichever occurs first, unless the City increases the contract amount or extends the contract duration. Work will be based on unit prices and the actual scope of work will be as needed and limited to \$300,000.

When you download the project documents, you will automatically be placed on the Plan Holders List. Bid proposals from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List will not be accepted.

Bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk until 2:00 p.m., according to official clock in City Clerk's Office, on **Thursday**, **February 1**, 2018, after which time they shall be opened in the City Council Chamber. Each bidder must submit a proposal to the City Clerk labeled:

All bids and supporting documents will become the property of the City of San Ramon and upon selection of the successful bidder and before award of the contract, all bids and supporting documents will become public records and subject to disclosure as required by the California Public Records Act.

Proposals shall be on standard forms which may be obtained from the office of the City Engineer and shall be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid submitted to be made payable to the City of San Ramon. The work includes the furnishing of all labor, supervision, materials, tools, plant and equipment for the construction of all items shown on the Plans (to be issued per work order) and Specifications for a complete and functional project.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond in the amount not less than one-hundred percent (100%) of contract price and a payment bond in the amount not less than one-hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. At the successful contractor's option, securities may be substituted for the required retention, in accordance with the provisions of Section 22300 of the State of California Public Contracts Code.

All bidders shall be licensed under the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California to do the type of work contemplated in the project and shall be skilled and regularly engaged in the general class or type of work called for under the contract. **The Contractor shall possess a Class A or C-8 license at the time this contract is awarded.** The Contractor and all subcontractors performing work in connection with this project must pay all laborers, workmen, and mechanics on said work, or any part thereof, not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for day, legal holidays and overtime work for work of a similar character in the location where the work is performed as set forth within the appropriate General Prevailing Wage Determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations, State of California, in accordance with Section 1770 of the California Labor Code.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code 1725.5.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids received and to waive irregularities in bids and the bid procedure as the public good may require.
