




Athan Downs - Public Art Project Conceptual Designs on Styrofoam

Notes from the Artist Madeline Wiener:

- All lines and forms will be clean...like the bicycle wheels will be round, not wobbly!
- The panel will contain 4 sides, Front (tennis) and back (family) will be 4 feet by 4 feet .
- The two end panels will be 2 feet thick and will tell a story with soldier saluting and scales of justice on one end, and jogger, flower and bicycle on the opposite end.
- There will be three benches in front of tennis side spaced far enough away so folks can sit and see the panel and tennis courts in the distance.
- The proposed material is Silverdale Limestone that is a warm yellow color with a soft blue vein running through it.
- The Foundation will be 6 inches of reinforced concrete 5 feet long x 3 feet front to back (allowing 6 inches all the way around the sculpture)
- $\frac{3}{4}$ inch stainless steel pins will be placed 8 inches into the relief and 4 inches into the foundation. The pins will be located 12 inches in from the outside - front/back/side
- There will be three benches 18 inches tall by 24 inches long by 18 inches from front to back.
- Each bench will be 3 feet apart from one another forming a slight arc mimicking the swoosh in the relief.
- Benches will have one pin each $\frac{3}{4}$ inch stainless set 6 inches into bench and 3-4 inches into slab
- Sculpture will be finished with Stone Pro Porous Plus air permeable silicon pregnator, brushed on towel dried. If it is scratched/dinged it can easily be filed and sanded with dry silicon carbide wet/or dry sandpaper.
