Answer: Chiller at Public Safety Complex installed 2023. Annual inspection of electrical components, check for leaks, inspect oil levels, check piping is properly supported, advise if additional work is necessary.

Boiler at Public Safety Complex installed 2010. Annual inspection and cleaning of heat exchanger, advise if additional work is necessary.

b. Typically packaged units and condensing units call for annual condenser coil cleaning; Does the city request this service to be performed for these units as well?

Answer: Yes, clean coil surfaces.
