



NOTICE OF PAVEMENT REPAIRS AND TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES

FROM: City of San Ramon

CONSTRUCTION PERIOD: September 2016 through November 2016

**SCHEDULED TEMPORARY
DELAY/CLOSURE DATES:** Tuesday, September 27, 2016 to Tuesday, October 21, 2016
(See attached List of Streets for anticipated dates per street)
("No Parking" signs will be posted at least 72 hours in advance)

Hours: Generally, 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. (unless otherwise posted)

WHAT'S BEING DONE:

Asphalt pavement repairs, wedge grinding, and crack sealing in preparation for asphalt overlay. These activities will consist of grinding existing roadways for the new pavement to conform to existing surfaces and repaving localized road failures. On streets receiving a 2-inch asphalt overlay, prior to the overlay, an asphalt leveling course will be applied to the road. Asphalt pavement overlays consist of hot asphalt mix spread and then rolled with a heavy roller. **These treatments will require some lane closures, delays in traffic, and parking restrictions.**

Road closures will not be on garbage pick-up days.

HOW YOU WILL BE AFFECTED:

During the planned work dates, Bay Cities Paving & Grading and their subcontractors will carry-out grinding, asphalt pavement repairs, crack sealing, and asphalt overlay operations at locations that may affect your normal parking and driving habits. **"No Parking" signs will be posted at least three days in advance of each work day to notify you of planned dates of construction in your neighborhood.** On those dates, construction crews may appear at any time. Therefore, you should make sure that your car is not parked on the posted roadway between the hours shown on the sign.

Please understand that the asphalt could take up to 4 hours to cure, prior to allowing vehicles onto the roadway. You should take extra precautions with children and pets to avoid any contact with the fresh oil. This material will permanently stain driveways, clothing, and carpeting.

PARKING AND DRIVING RESTRICTIONS:

A PORTION of your street and/or neighboring streets will be closed for the above-mentioned activities to occur. **No parking and limited driving** will be permitted on the days of work. Therefore, you should make sure that your car is not parked on the posted roadway between the hours shown on the “No Parking” signs. If you need to drive your car during the hours of closure, you will need to plan to park on the nearby streets or other locations not designated for closure by "No Parking" signs. Any cars remaining on the street during the posted hours will be towed. (NOTE: In the event that rain or other unforeseen delays, the work will be rescheduled as soon as possible.)

Your street will remain open on all other work days while preparatory and restriping operations are in progress. On asphalt paving days, you will have two options for parking:

- 1) Park in Driveway or Garage
You may choose to park in your garage or driveway, but you must expect possible delays and/or rough, difficult driving surfaces. Delays are uncommon, and when they occur, are usually less than 10-15 minutes. However, if crews encounter difficulties immediately in front of your driveway, there is a slight risk of delays reaching 1-2 hours.
- 2) Park on Nearby Street not Designated for Construction on the Same Day
If you cannot afford to be delayed, or want to avoid driving under adverse road conditions, you should plan on parking on another nearby street not posted for work, and walk between your house and your car.

Unfortunately, due to unforeseen conflicts that can occur, we cannot guarantee that the work will occur on the dates scheduled. IMPACT ON OTHER SERVICES (GARBAGE PICK-UP, MAIL, ETC.):

You should not expect any change in scheduled dates for delivery or pick-up services (garbage collection, mail, etc.) Although delivery times may change, dates will not be affected. Residents will be notified by flyer of any exceptions.
