



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

PG&E GAS LINE TEE CAP REPLACEMENT PROJECT @ RANCHO SAN RAMON SUBDIVISION NEAR ALCOSTA BOULEVARD AND TWIN CREEKS SUBDIVISION AREA NEAR BOLLINGER CANYON ROAD

Planned construction period: October 31, 2016 to December 30, 2016

The City has issued multiple encroachment permits to PG&E for their Gas Line Tee Cap Replacement Project, part of PG&E's commitment to safety and upgrading parts of their natural gas distribution system, including individual service lines. The work involves PG&E placing a cap on the gas service Tee using a typical method of an excavation of 12 inch wide hole. Approximately 95% of the Tee Caps to be replaced are located at the back or under the sidewalk and the remaining 5% are on the streets. PG&E will remove and replace all segments of sidewalks and open cut streets affected by the work per the City Standard details.

A total of approximately **133** tee caps will be replaced, **46** in Rancho San Ramon near Alcosta Boulevard and **87** in the Twin Creeks area near Bollinger Canyon Road as shown on Exhibit A and B. PG&E/Contractor trucks and other heavy equipment will be in the area during construction. Work at each location is expected to take a few hours and should not interrupt any gas service. A faint smell of natural gas may occur as PG&E/Contractor complete the upgrades, these circumstances are normal when crews are working, but PG&E encourages anyone who has concerns to call PG&E at **1-800-743-5000**.

PG&E/Contractor plans to begin work on October 31st and preparatory work already begun includes USA pavement markings, the posting of work notification signs on the subject streets regarding the upcoming work, and the distribution of notices to residents in proximity to the work zone. PG&E anticipates project completion by the end of December 2016.

City staff reviewed and approved the traffic control plans for the work and will work closely with PG&E to minimize traffic disruption, especially during peak morning and afternoon commute times, near schools, and on all main arterial roadways.

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The City would like to thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation during construction.



