



CITY OF SAN RAMON AQUATIC PICNIC RESERVATION INFORMATION



HOURS AND AVAILABILITY:

- Aquatic Picnic Areas can be reserved for use during Recreation Swim hours. Recreation Swim Hours are subject to change.
- Recreation Swim Hours:
 - June 13 — August 14
 - Mon—Fri: 12:30pm — 3:30pm
 - Sat—Sun: 12:30pm—4:30pm
 - August 20— September 25
 - Sat—Sun: 12:30pm—4:30pm

**Picnic Reservations will not be accepted more than 90 days prior to rental date.

HOW DO I RESERVE?

- Aquatic Picnic Areas must be reserved in person at San Ramon Olympic Pool by appointment.
- To confirm a picnic reservation the following are required: Submission of application, payment, and completion of a picnic reservation agreement. All rental fees and deposits are due at the time of booking.
 - Payments can be made by using cash, check (Payable to the *City of San Ramon*) or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or American Express).
- A prospective renter may tour any of the City of San Ramon facilities during open hours, respecting the privacy of individuals using those facilities.
- Phone-in, Mail-in or Fax-in reservations will not be accepted for aquatic picnic reservations (Interested parties may call our offices to inquire about availability).
- Picnic reservations may not be booked less five days prior to the event date.
- Contact the San Ramon Olympic Pool directly for all aquatic center picnic or pool rentals.

WHAT IF I HAVE TO CANCEL?

- Reservations that are canceled may be subject to penalties. Upon receipt of cancellation notice, penalties if applicable, will be applied as follows:
 - Aquatic Picnic areas: **No refunds or cancellations unless a rainout is declared**
 - Note: The City of San Ramon will determine rainouts during weather inclinations. If an event is rained out, a full refund can be requested or a credit will be issued for use scheduled during the same season (This does not apply for aquatic facilities.)
- If the City of San Ramon cancels or reschedules a previously scheduled event at a time, which is deemed unsatisfactory by the reserving group or individual, all rental fees paid will be refunded.







"Li'l Squirt" Water Slide at the San Ramon Olympic Pool

<p>NOTE: An entrance fee is required for each person entering the Aquatic Center, regardless of use of the facilities. Pool Party Passes provide a 10% discount off the General Admission Fee for parties of 25 and 15% discount for parties of 50. The Pool Party Pass includes wristbands to allow access to the Pool Deck.</p> <p><i>* Non-Residents are permitted to make reservations for use Monday—Friday only at the San Ramon Olympic Pool</i></p> <p>Aquatic Center Picnic Areas are only available for reservation during Recreation Swim Hours.</p>				
<p>Deposit Refunds: Picnic areas must be returned to the original condition in order to receive a full deposit refund. Damages and rental overtime will result in the loss of the deposit. Deposit refunds will be issued after the completion of the picnic rental in the original form of payment.</p>				

POLICIES AND USE RESTRICTIONS

San Ramon residents and businesses may reserve picnic areas any day of the week. Non-resident individuals and businesses may reserve picnic areas on weekdays only at the San Ramon Olympic Pool.

Reservations for aquatic picnic areas will not be accepted more than 90 days prior to use date.

Aquatic picnic reservations are limited to one reservation per picnic area, per day. Staff discretion prevails to determine whether two events may be booked at the same pool on the same day.

Pool Party Pass wristbands must be purchased at the time of booking. A Pool Party pass includes the amount of entry passes that your rented section allows. (25 per section)

Any additional rental entrance above the party limit must be paid at the General Admission Fee or an additional Swim Pass may be purchased. See Swim Pass Fees for pricing.

Splash 'N Dash requires an additional \$3 per person.

The contract holder must be present the day of the event. Reservations may not be transferred, assigned or sublet.

On the day of your party, you must have a party representative available in the lobby to greet and check in guests. The party representative will be responsible for giving a wristband to each party guest who will enter the pool deck area. (Non-swimmers require a wristband as well.)

Rentals are permitted entry to rented sections 15 minutes prior to recreation swim for set up and 15 minutes after recreation swim for take down. Overtime beyond the allowed 15 minutes will result in loss of deposit.

The renter must agree to take full responsibility for the behavior exhibited by his/her attendees, guests, staff and contractors.

Patrons are responsible for personal property. City of San Ramon cannot be held liable for items left in or around any facilities or parks.

City staff will post a reservation placard at picnic site before the event.

The use of amplified sound requires a permit. Please refer to *Section B6-115: Amplified Sound*.

The following are prohibited within the facility;

- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes)
- Alcoholic Beverages
- Glass Containers
- Portable BBQs and Chaffing Dishes
- Animals, with the exception of service animals
- Piñatas
- Outside Vendors
- Advertisement/selling of products or services

Tables and canopies are not allowed to be brought into the facility. Umbrellas are allowed but cannot go more than 6 inches into the ground. Stakes may not be driven into any concrete or asphalt areas.

Signage and decorations may not be attached to any existing structure or facility including walls, trash bins, columns, light posts, and windows. Applicants and their guests may decorate their reserved areas only. The Renter is responsible for removal and proper disposal of all decorations.

In the event that there are damages to equipment or the facility as a result of the rental, the renter is responsible for all replacement costs for damages. Replacement costs and repairs will be assessed and contracted or repaired by the City of San Ramon.
