

Graham Russell & Russell Hitchcock met on May 12, 1975, the first day of rehearsals for "Jesus Christ Superstar" in Sydney, Australia; they became instant friends with their common love for The Beatles and, of course, singing. Discovered by Clive Davis and signed to Arista Record in 1980, their first American single "Lost in Love" became the fastest selling single in the world. The trademark sound of Russell Hitchcock's soaring tenor voice and Graham Russell's simple yet majestic songs created a unique sound that would forever be known as *Air Supply*. For all of their recording success it is their live performances that have sustained their career for over thirty years.
