

# What goes in my Recycling cart?



Plastics: narrow neck bottles & jugs #1-7 and wide mouth tubs #2, #4, #5



Paper: phone books, newspapers, junk mail, office paper, magazines, catalogs and paper bags



Paper egg cartons, drink boxes, cereal boxes & shoe boxes



Aluminum, steel and empty aerosol cans



Glass bottles and jars



Flattened non-waxed corrugated cardboard

## Service day reminders

- Place carts, oil jugs and oil filters at curbside by 5:30 a.m. Do not block sidewalk. Allow 3 feet of clearance around all carts & 6 feet between carts and stationary objects.
- No hazardous or toxic waste
- Don't overpack carts. Lids must close completely to prevent fly-aways and harm to drivers when carts are serviced.

Empty & wipe or rinse containers. Remove caps, corks & straws. Always cut & flatten cardboard to fit loosely inside cart with lid closed. If cart is too full to hold cardboard, lean flattened pieces against outside of cart.

### Recycle plastic bags at the curb!
