

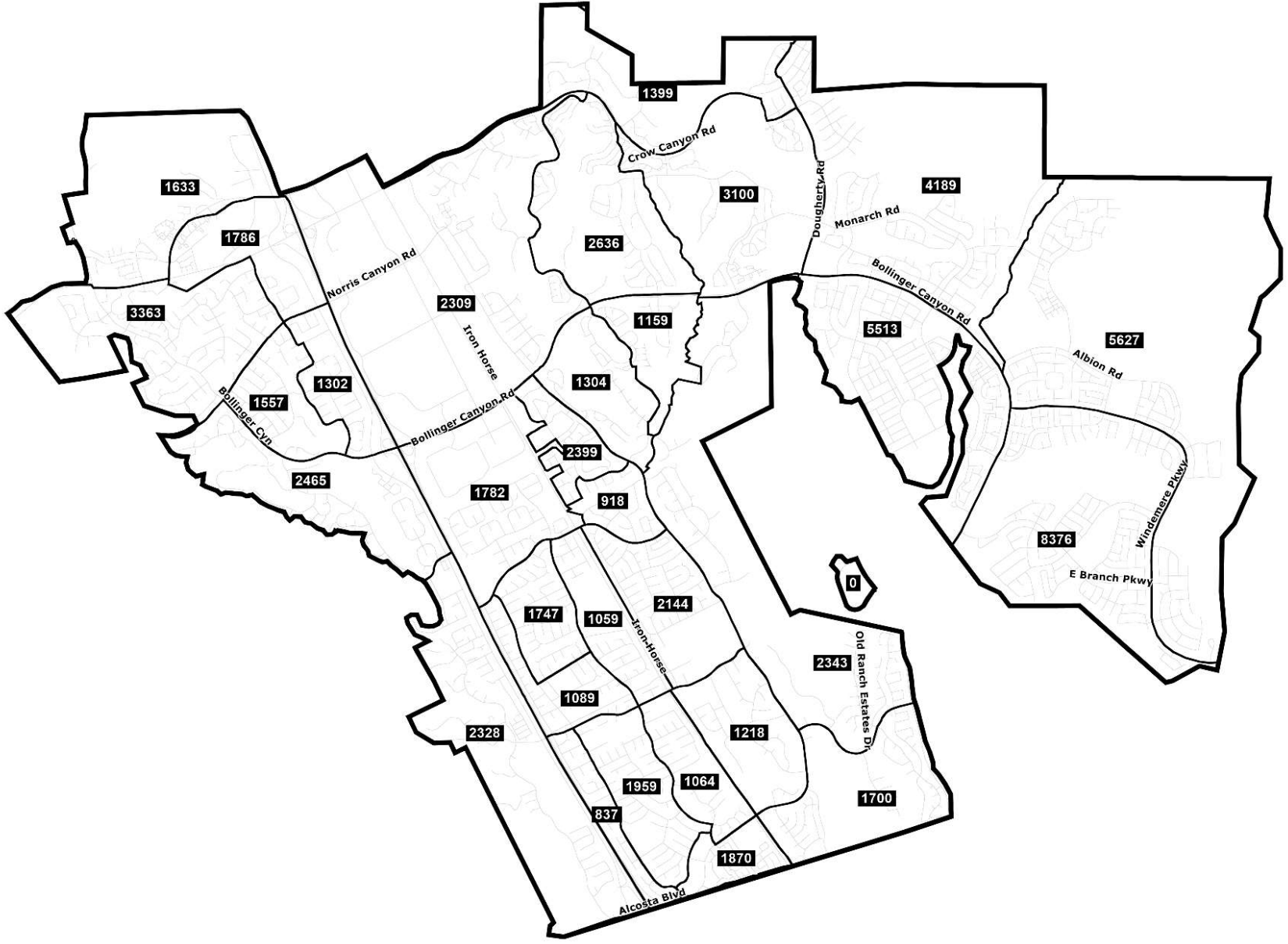
2019 San Ramon Redistricting Proposal

Instructions

1. San Ramon has been divided into 32 different geographic units called slices based on census geography to help facilitate the submission of redistricting plans by members of the public.
2. The total population and location of these slices are available on the attached maps. More detailed demographics are available on the “Demographics Data Chart.” An interactive map of the slices and demographic data is available at http://www.sanramon.ca.gov/residents/district_elections
3. Enter your contact information on the “Plan Submission Map”
4. Then use a thick dark-colored pen on the included map to draw four proposed districts.
5. Districts must be contiguous, meaning that you can draw a single, uninterrupted line around the boundary of each district.
6. Districts should be as nearly equal in population as you can get them, with the understanding that the law may require some adjustments to comply with the principle of one person, one vote.
7. Other criteria to consider include, but are not limited to, whether your districts are contiguous and compact, respect communities of interest and neighborhoods, and follow natural and man-made geography and topography.
8. You may optionally include supporting materials describing your map including the justification for your district boundaries and the goals you were trying to achieve.
9. Email the map to districtelections@sanramon.ca.gov or drop off or mail to 7000 Bollinger Canyon Road. Maps must be received by 5PM on April 12, 2019.

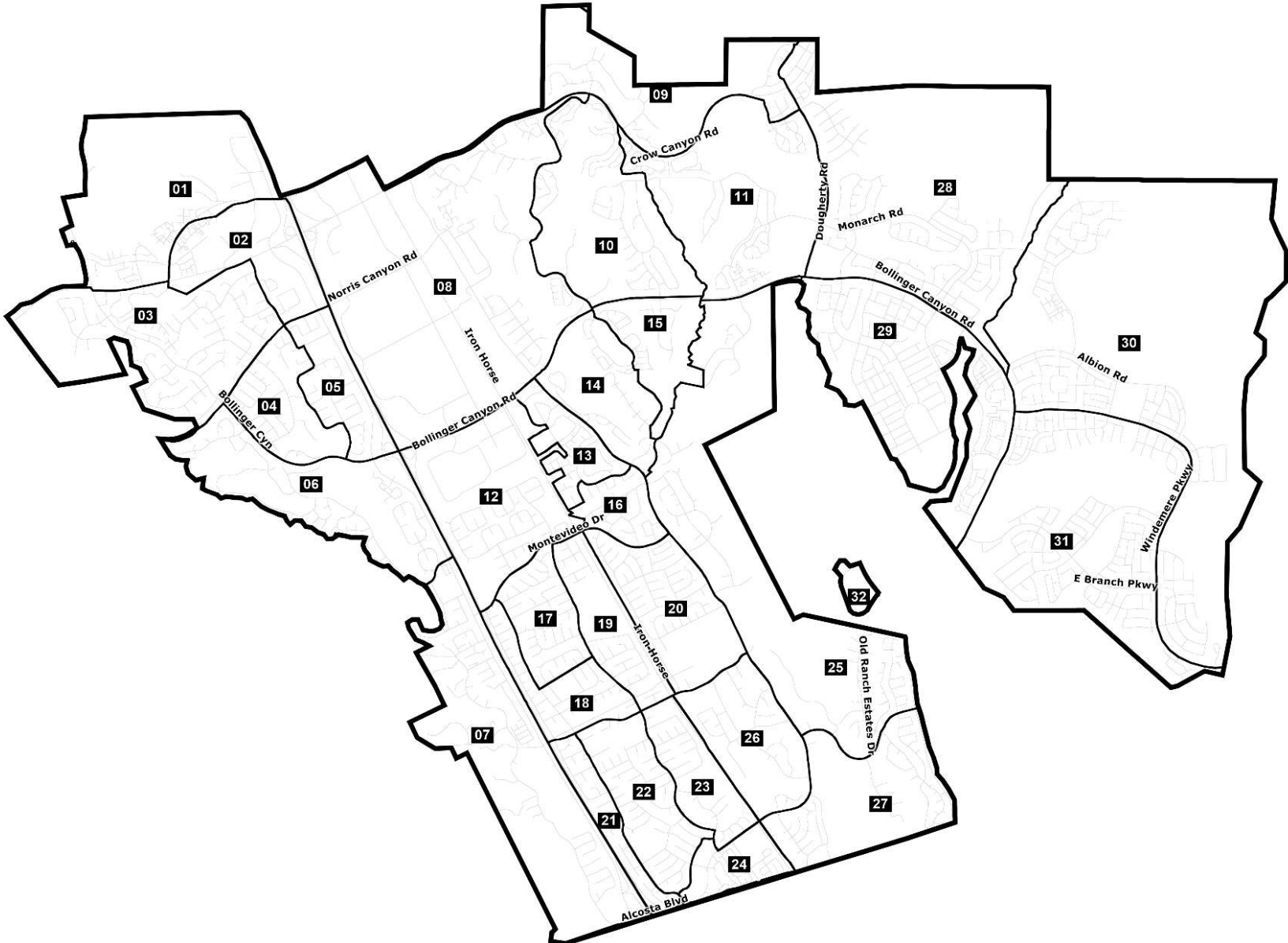
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Population Map

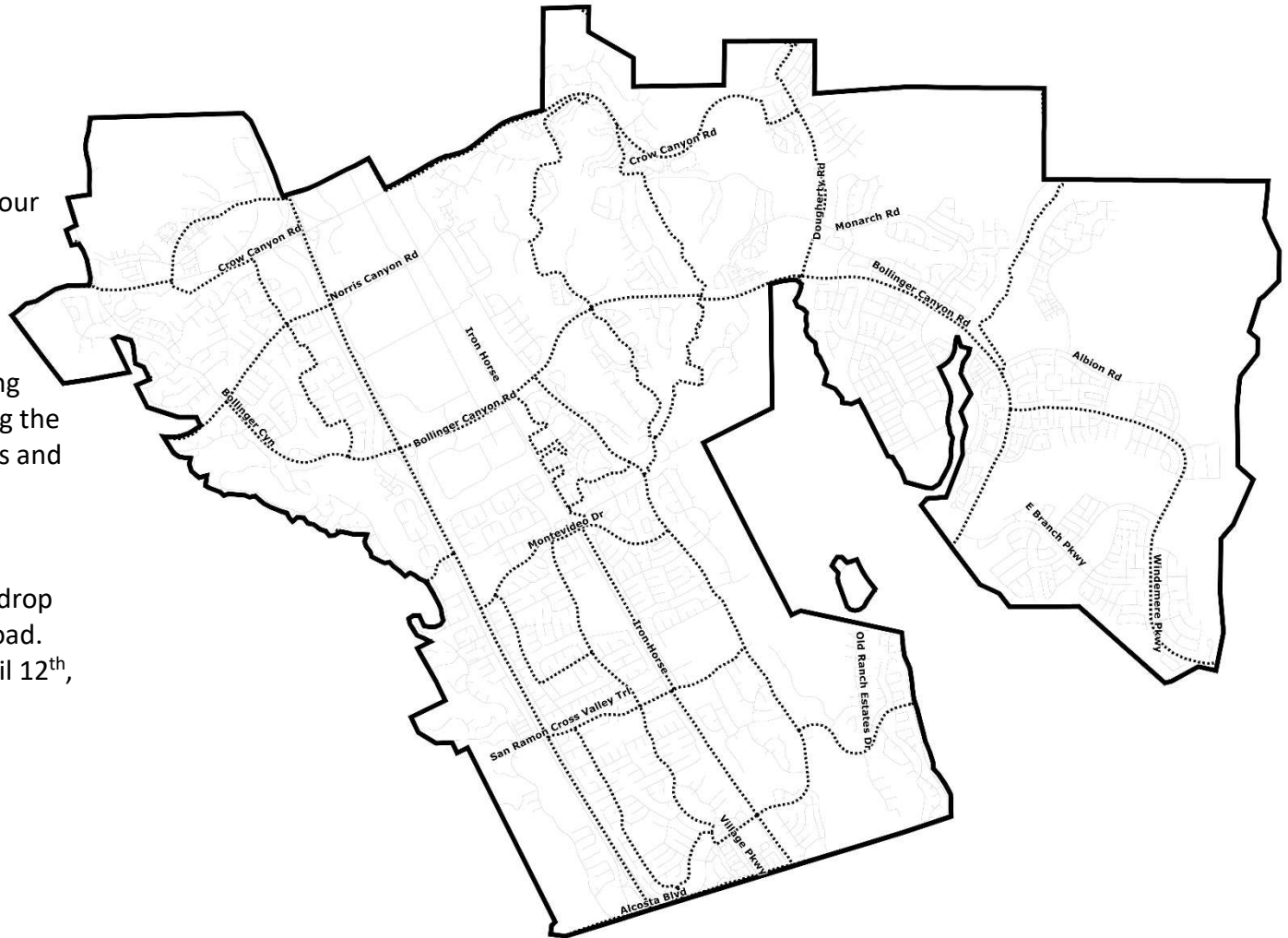
