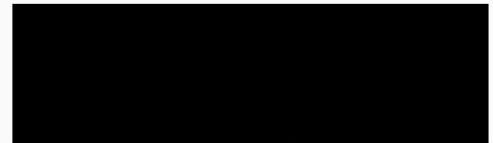
- **I understand small business**--I have lived in San Ramon for 23 years and started a small business in our City with my husband in 1998.
